3. GEOPARK ACTIVITIES

Major achievements in 2022

- free activity, open to all, to raise awareness of energy saving and the culture of "no waste": symbolic switching off of lights, walk in San Valentino's village in the light of front lamps and LED torches and guided tour of the "Museo delle Ambre e dei Fossili" (Amber and Fossils Museum), always with lights off, to better know the section dedicated to Valle Giumentina, important geosite of the Geopark. The initiative was organized in collaboration with the San Valentino in A. C. Municipality on the occasion of the initiative "M'illumino di meno" launched by a national radio broadcast (March 11);
- activities for students: guided tour to the "Daniela Brescia" Botanical Garden with a focus on Maiella UGGp, traditional and modern uses of wild plants (intangible heritage) and the importance of pollinators for the biodiversity and the life on the Planet. This initiative was organized during the EGN Week 2022 (May 24);
- educational and recreational activity for children about the cave fauna: tales, experiences and games on bats (within the Adriaticaves plus Project stakeholders workshop for the promotion of underground tourism). This initiative was organized during the EGN Week 2022 (May 27);
