3. GEOPARK ACTIVITIES

Major achievements in 2022

- Held the 3rd Geotourism Festival & International Conference 2022 with 750 participants both online and offline and was supported by about 120 local community members in preparing the event. The conference was openned by the Minister of Tourism & Creative Economy of the Republic of Indonesia; there were dozens of Geotourism experts from the world participating and sharing their knowledge in this event. This event were also produced: (1) Facilitating the signing of MoU between UGGp Rinjani-Lombok and Kaldera Toba UGGp, Rinjani-Lombok UGGp and Lombok Tourism Polytechnic, Rinjani-Lombok UGGp, and Merangin-Jambi Aspiring UGGp, and Kaldera Toba UGGp and Gunung Batur UGGp. (2) There were several awards given to people who contributed more to the development of geotourism, empowering women and developing geoparks who were regional leaders in Maros-Pangkep and the Indonesian Geotourism Society. Publish the International Journal of Geotourism Science and Development. This journal is one of the output for the Geotourism Development (particularly Geotourism Festival & International Conference). This journal was built to support the development of Geotourism in Indonesia through academic researches and become the first Geotourism journal in Indonesia.
- Held NTB Youth Conference. This event is a 4 pre-summit Y20 and the theme raised was digital transformation. Some of the results obtained are: (1) The results of the Focus Group Discussion (FGD) of 100 of the best young people in NTB and other central parts of Indonesia in the theme of 'the role of young people in digital governance' and 'digital financial literacy. The FGD was based on the White Paper and presentations from the official Indonesian delegation in this Y20 (Marcel Satria) (2) 22 exhibitors from the NTSB's outstanding community and MSMEs participated in the exhibition and had the opportunity to expand their network The field trip held specifically to the Sembalun Geosite provided an opportunity for cooperation and digital transformation development for young people and Geoparks.

Geoconservation

- Initiate the Sembalun Ecosystem Program, a holistic approach to protect the geosite 9: Sembalun Valley. This program is a sustainable project which is consist of Sembalun Daur (green Sembalun), Protection of Springs and Ground Water, Assistance in the Adiwyata School in Sembalun (A school that cares about a healthy, clean and beautiful environment)
- Facilitate and support the Geo-Adventure Camp. The activities in this event included a Zero
 Waste Trekking, Tourism Discussion, Clean Up, and Tree Planting. After the event, participants
 were required to write about their experiences and publish them on their respective social
 media accounts.
- Facilitate and support FGD Strategy to Strengthen Urban Waste Community program, this
 program is a sustainable project which is an activity aimed at identifying patterns, sharing
 knowledge and best practices, and strengthening communities in supporting the zero waste
 program of the West Nusa Tenggara Provincial Government.
- Initiate Women Geo-Adventure Camp. This is Literacy program to promote zero-waste trekking to trekking organizers and Rinjani climbers.

Sustainable tourism (Geotourism)

- Workshop on Geotrail & Story Line Preparation. The Workshop for the Development of Geotrail
 & Storyline for Geotourism-based Marine Tourism is one of the post events of The 3rd
 Geotourism Festival & International Conference 2022 and 30 people were selected as the core
 team for interpretive guides, identifying flagship tourism attractions, and developing raw
 packages from various community groups
- Geotourism Guide Workshop and Training. This activity aimed to improve the quality of tourism practitioners, particularly in the Senaru area (Bayan), as a form of cooperation between the Rinjani Lombok Geopark and Mataram University.
- Facilitate and support the Geopark-Based Tourism Destination Management Training.

New education programmes on geoconservation, sustainable development and disaster risk reduction

- Beboka Nursery, a Nursery program for firebreak plants to mitigate the forest and landfire hazard in Sembalun area
- linitiated the formation of the Rinjani Geopark Youth Forum through the Educamp series. That educamp was held 2 times with different themes, namely: (1) turtle and coral reef conservation
 (2) environmental journalism, the cultural history of Sembalun, and the rich geology of the Sembalun area
- Rinjani Literacy Development program. The aims in this program is to educate the public about the Rinjani Geopark, with a focus on geology, conservation, cultural diversity, and biological diversity.
- Preparation and Practice of Modules Rinjani Geopark Learning for Students. the modules compiled cover writing techniques, photography techniques, and videography techniques. Each material is accompanied by practice and its goals are in the form of conten.
- Spice for Life program. The Spice for Life Program is a geotourism development activity based on the potential of biodiversity combined with geological and cultural aspects as a characteristic of geopark-based development.
- Compilation of Geopark Rinjani-Themed Book. The Compilation of Geopark Rinjani-Themed Book is based on the absence of books containing information about the local environment and culture, specifically the environment in Rinjani Geopark and the culture of the community living in the Rinjani Geopark area
- Empowering Youth RGYF (Rinjani Geopark Youth Forum). This program is a continuation of RGYF Educamp series activities, and in 2022 three RGYF empowerment programs were implemented: Strengthening Institutions related to Waste (Zero Waste), International Geopark Youth Forum Summer Camp, and RGYF Anniversary.
- International Day for Disaster Risk Reduction 2022. The series of activities in IDRR 2022 include Coloring Contest for Kindergarten & Elementary School (Grades 1 & 2); a Storytelling Contest for Junior High School; Poetry Writing & Reading Contest for Junior High School; Earth & Disaster Quiz; Disaster Debate Contest; and Reels Contest. All of these activities have started since September and reached their peak on October 11-13, 2022. IDDR 2022 tries to involve various ages including children to become agents of change in disaster mitigation
