- Contributors to all the activities of the Spanish Forum related to the International Year of Caves and Karst (extended to 2022 due to the pandemics).
- Participation in the Education Working Group of the EGN.

Management and Financial Status

- Similar budget than previous years.
- Change in the Management Structure. The place of the former manager has been replaced by a management committee.

Geoconservation

- 9 Geosites declared Global Geosites by the Spanish Geological Survey.
- Geopark's Resesearch Grant given to a project to quantify enduro bikes erosion.
- We have presented the Aragon Government with a plea against photovoltaic fields in La Fueva valley.

Sustainable tourism (Geotourism)

- Implementation of a Carbon Footprint quantification methodology in the Geopark and partner enterprises.
- Active collaboration in the frame of the Spanish Ecotourism Club, of which we are members.
- Launching of a new app to improve the management of the panels.
- Advances in the EXCAVA Program, which meets archeologists with geopark's volunteers.

New education programmes on geoconservation, sustainable development and disaster risk reduction

- Realization of the III Workshop on dry stone building.
- Development of new activities concerning the Glacier's Fest.

Strategic partnership

- We keep all the previous partnership with national and international institutions.
- Renewal of the partnership with the Goiàs University (Brasil).
- Creation of the working group "Megalithic Geoparks" with Causes du Quercy and Famme Ardenne UGGps.

Promotional activities

- Participation in FITUR with the Ecotourism Club of Spain and the Spanish Geoparks.
- Participation in the itinerant exhibition "Geoparques de Aragón", promoted by the Aragón Regional Government.

- Boosting of the "Escaleretas route" related to four sites of the ARAMPI World Heritage Site, within our Geopark.
- We have completed the signposting (both interpretative and directional) of the Geopark's megaliths.
- Invited territory in the FERMA fair in the frame of the Sustainable Development in the Mountains International Year.
- Workshop to promote the Geopark among the staff of the Ordesa and Monte Perdido National Park and local tourist offices.
