2. GEOPARK FIGURES

Number of Geopark staffs:

Three direct staff members, including technical and coordination assistance and the geologist. Nevertheless, the main administrative body is composed by seven members (mayors of the town councils of Cariño, Cedeira, Cerdido, Moeche, Ortigueira, San Sadurniño and Valdoviño)

• Number of visitors: 22.213 visitors.

The number of visitors is estimated taking into account the data from the tourism offices, tourist attractions, interpretation centers and museums located in the geopark.

- Collaboration agreement with the Provincial Council of A Coruña. Nominative subsidy for the co-financing of the project "Activities of the Cabo Ortegal Geopark Project": 239.943,00€.
- Subsidy for the improvement of quality, competitiveness and tourist activity of entities in the province of A Coruña: 134.000,00€.
