# **Management and Financial Status**

- Geopark management is overseen by North Gyeongsang Province, with operational duties entrusted to Cheongsong County
- Funding is jointly supported by the central government, North Gyeongsang Province, and Cheongsong County

# Geoconservation

- All geological sites are legally protected under the Cultural Protection Law, Natural Park Law, and the Cheongsong Geopark Ordinance for Management and Maintenance
- Monthly monitoring is conducted to ensure regular maintenance and facility repairs

Geopark guides have voluntarily conducted monthly cleanup activities to preserve geological

sites

**Sustainable tourism (Geotourism)** 

Guided tours are conducted by local residents trained as certified Geopark interpreters. In

2024, approximately 3,100 participants took part in these commentary programs

• The Geopark team actively participated in regional events such as the Apple Festival,

Youth Festival, and Children's Day celebrations, operating interactive promotional booths.

Notably, during the Apple Festival, sand from the wrestling arena was reused to create a

fossil excavation experience zone. Proceeds from these activities were donated as

scholarships for local youth in the Cheongsong UNESCO Global Geopark (UGGp) area

New education programmes on geoconservation, sustainable development and disaster risk

reduction

A strategic agreement is being pursued with local apple-related businesses—Cheongsong's

representative crop that has been affected by climate change—to co-develop sustainable

tourism programs.

Cleanup activities have been actively carried out, with a report and promotional campaign

scheduled for December to raise awareness and encourage community participation.

Strategic partnership

In partnership with the Cheongsong Office of Education, joint education activities and

participation in the regional Education Festival have been carried out.

• Sisterhood relationships were established with Aso UNESCO Global Geopark (Japan) and

Hwanggang Dabieshan UNESCO Global Geopark (China) to strengthen international

cooperation.

Collaborative educational tourism programs have also been launched in partnership with

other geoparks within the same province.
