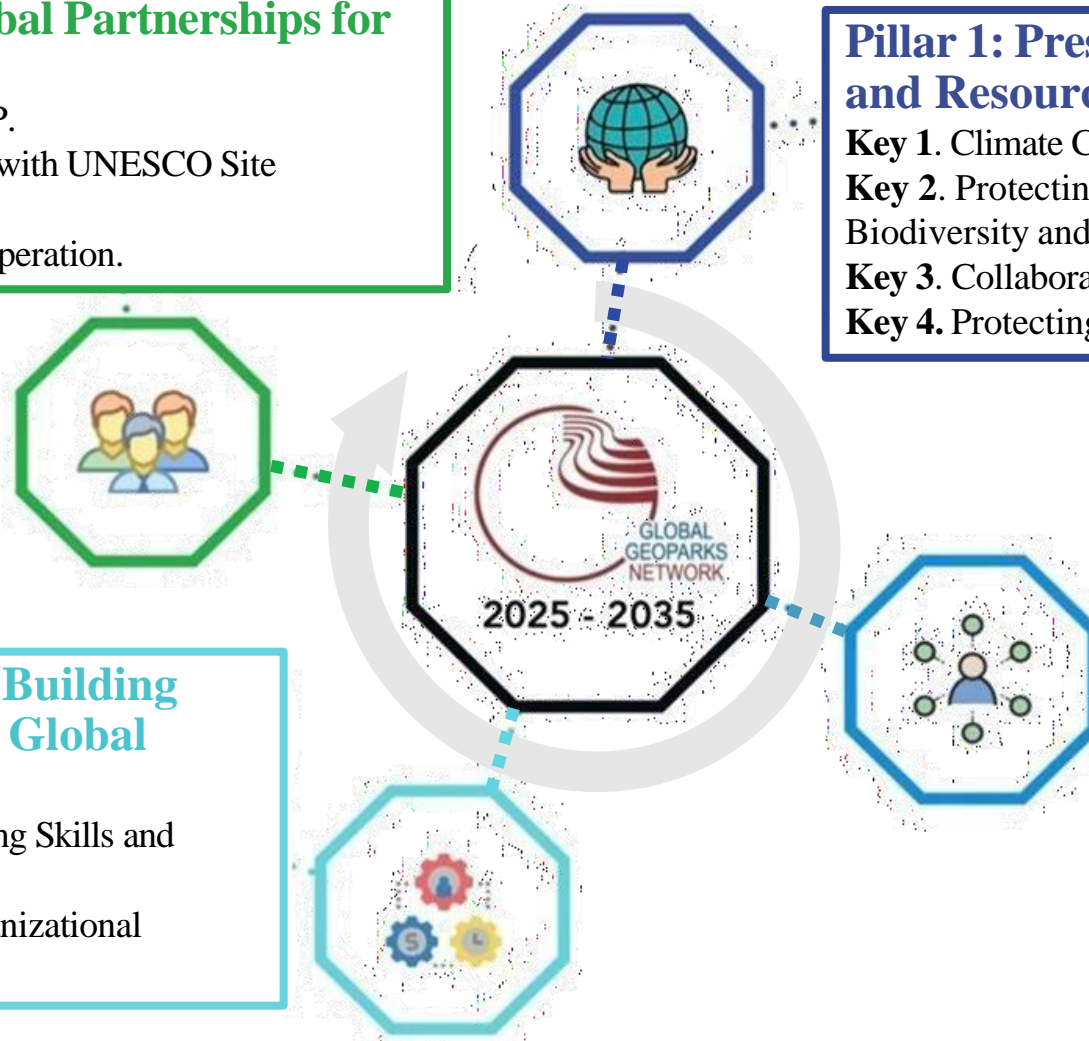

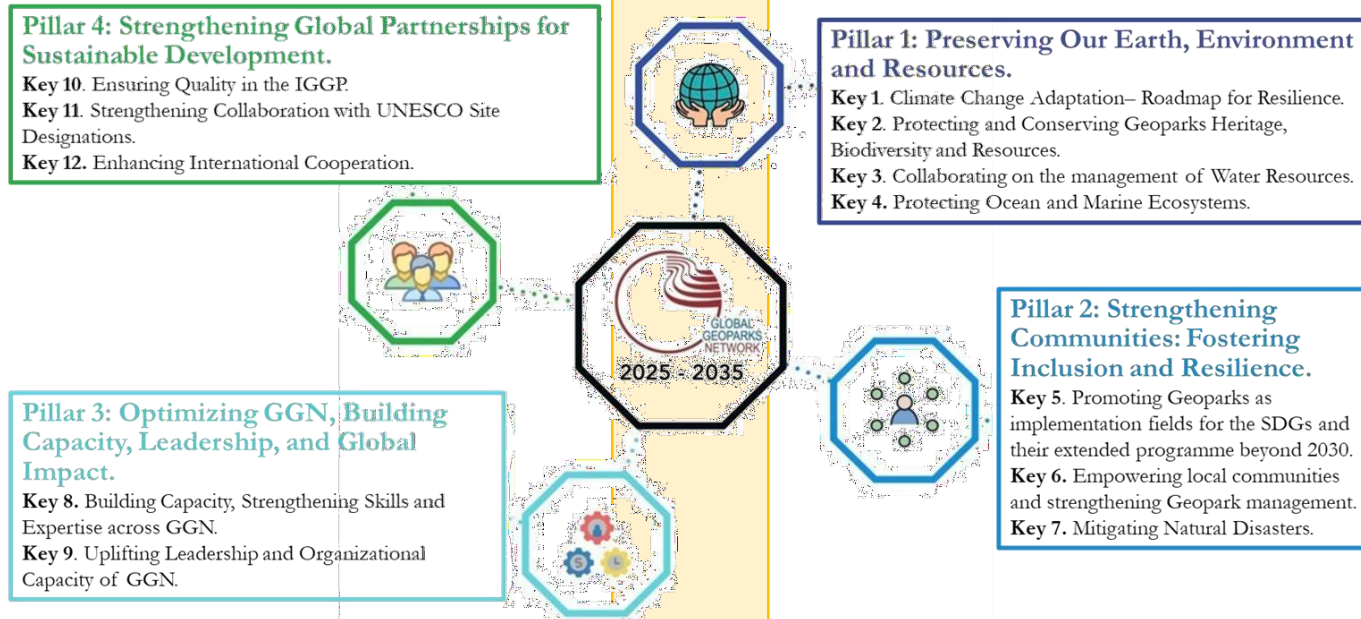

Results.

¿Which GGN or SGGN activities are appropriate for developing collaborative activities between UNESCO-designated sites?

Summary compilation of proposals:

1. Promote joint projects: research, SDGs, exchange of good practices, intangible heritage, promotion of local products, educational programs, volunteering, environmental conservation. These projects can be leveraged through EU or international cooperation calls.
2. Promote communication, visibility, and shared agendas (e.g., European Geoparks Week).
3. GGN cooperation with UNESCO and other UNESCO designations to foster cooperation between sites.
4. Program conferences and events for outreach and experience sharing, or famtrips, between UNESCO-designated sites. This program also includes programs for schools.
5. In the revalidation report, assess the links with other UNESCO designations (physical or intellectual overlap, synergies, or collaborations with non-territorial designations).

Summary compilation of proposals:

1. Visibility events such as workshops, seminars, exhibitions, international conferences, and events (e.g., EGN Week) of the GGN and regional networks:
Shared UNESCO values. Dissemination of good practices. Agenda 2030.
2. Promotional elements for common use in fairs, publications, campaigns on UNESCO territories, etc.
3. Inter-designation training courses.
4. REGM. Create a map of all UNESCO entities at the national level to facilitate collaboration between them. UNESCO Network. Promotion of UNESCO clubs and tourist routes.
5. Cooperation projects between designations. Associated funds for projects.

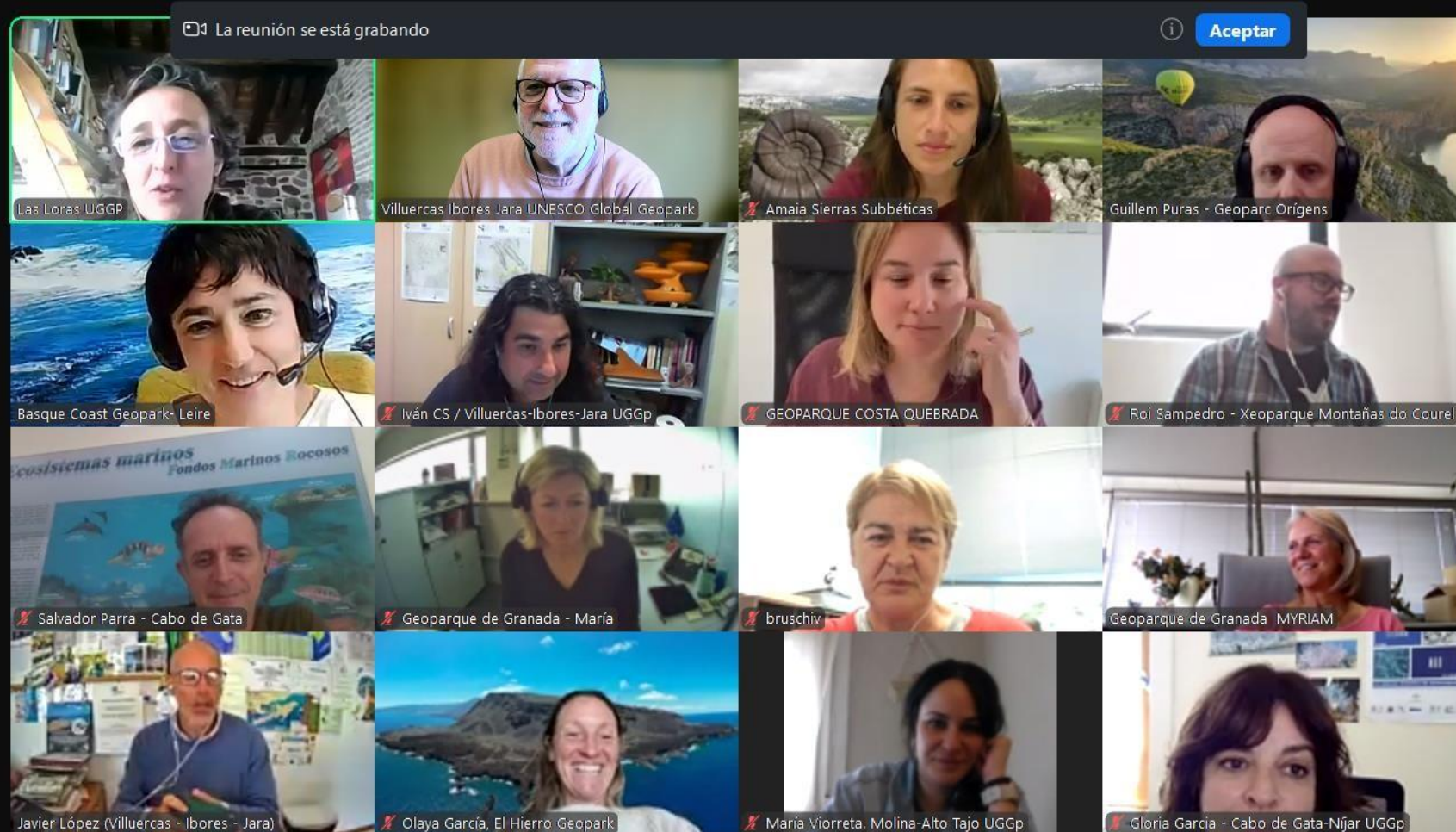
