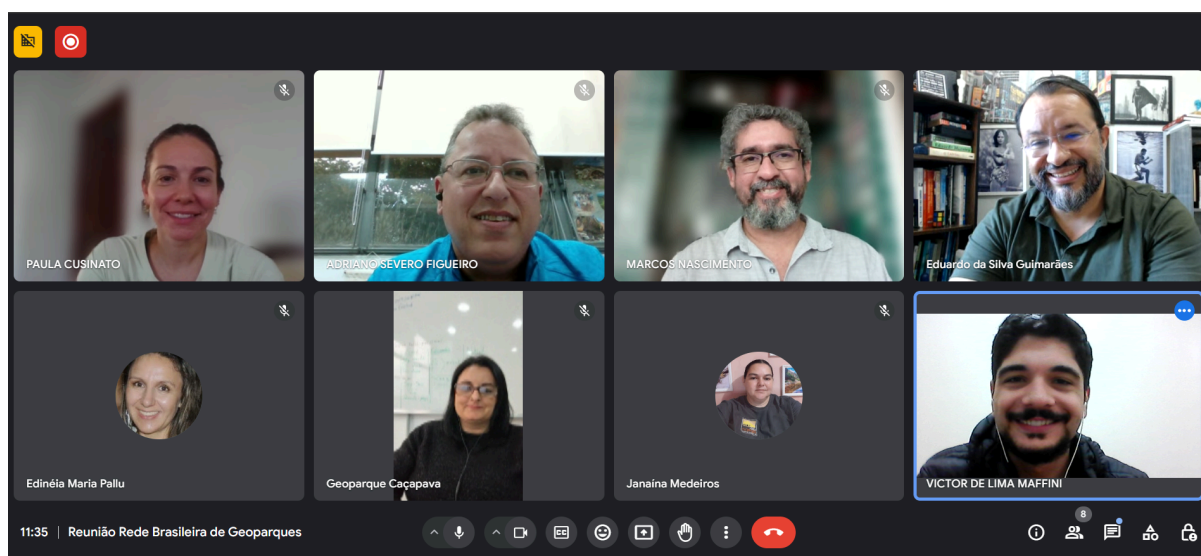
Participation in the National Tourism Fair

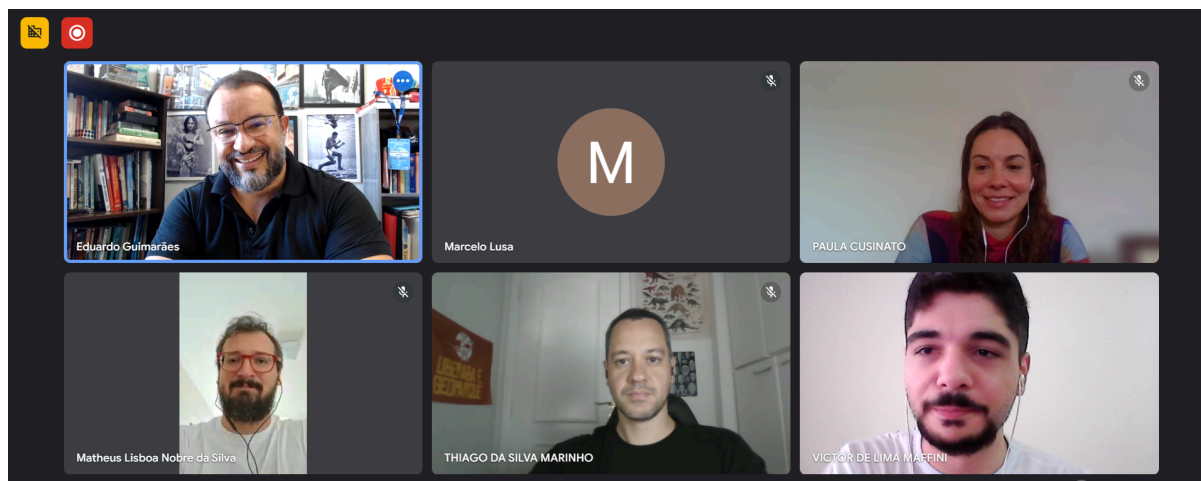
In August, the National Tourism Fair was held in Rio de Janeiro, organized by the Ministry of Tourism (MTUR). Through UNESCO Brazil and MTUR, the six Brazilian UNESCO Global Geoparks (GMU), Araripe GMU, Caçapava GMU, Caminhos dos Cânions do Sul GMU, Seridó GMU, Quarta Colônia GMU, and Uberaba GMU, were invited and attended the event at the Geoparks Space, inside the tourist experiences pavilion.

According to data from MTUR itself, around 10,000 (ten thousand) visitors attended the event and visited the RBGp stand, where they had direct contact with the concept of GMU, sustainable development, and actions carried out in each Geopark territory in Brazil.

Drafting and approval of the Internal Regulations

Following the meeting in Rio de Janeiro, work began on structuring the RBGp Internal Regulations based on the GeoLAC Regulations. The Fourth GMU Colony, as coordinator of the Network, with the assistance of Uberaba GMU, began writing the document, which was reviewed and collaboratively developed by the other GMUs in Brazil. On the occasion of the VII Conference of the Latin American and Caribbean Geoparks Network (GeoLAC), held in the territory of the Southern Canyons Route GMU, the final meeting for the drafting, correction, and approval of the RBGp Internal Regulations was held. The meeting was attended by representatives from all GMUs, Aspiring Geoparks, and Project Geoparks in the country, as well as GeoLAC Coordinator Emmaline González. Finally, the meeting set the date for the election of the Network's coordination for the 2026-2027 biennium, to be held virtually at the end of the year.

Elections for Coordination for the 2025-2026 biennium

At the end of 2024, the election meeting for the next RGBp management was organized, with the participation of GeoLAC Coordinator Emmaline Rosado as an observer. After the presentation of each candidacy and voting, the following composition of the board of directors was defined:

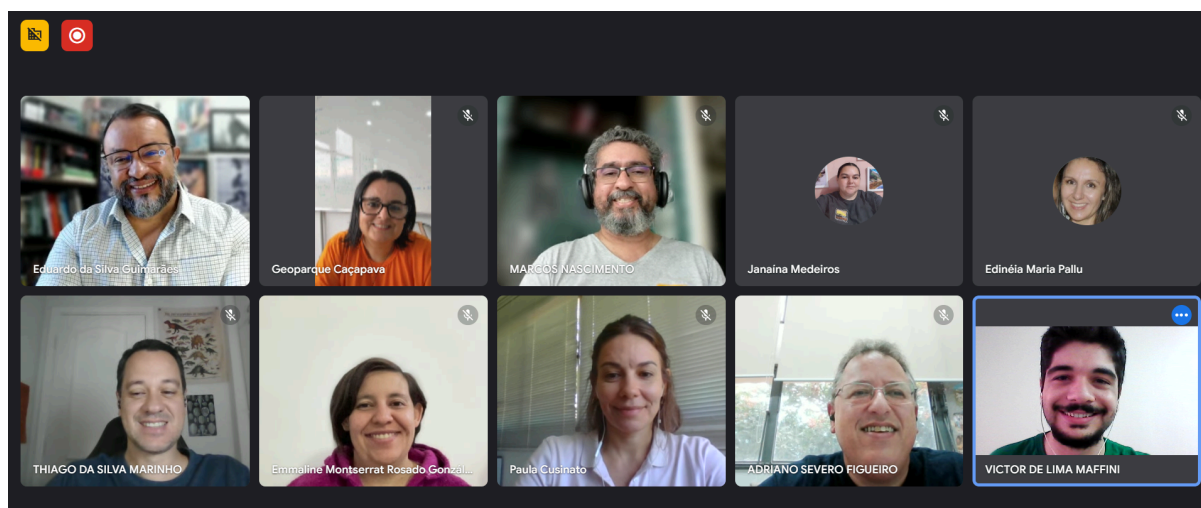
