4.2 Annual Committee Meeting in Drégelypalánk, 14.11.2024.

The Committee held its annual meeting in the village of Drégelypalánk in November 2024.

During the meeting the newly designated Bükk Region UNESCO Global Geopark's two

appointed committee representatives were introduced. The possibility of the establishment of an EGTC for the management of the Novohrad–Nógrád UGGp were raised. Geodiversity Day, Third 100 IUGS Geological Heritage Site and various subjects were discussed.

4.3 V4 Geopark Committee Meeting in Příbram, Barrandien National Geopark, 12–15.05.2024.

In the 3-day meeting of the National Committees of the Visegrád 4 countries (Poland, Czech Republic, Slovak Republic, Hungary) the representatives of the Hungarian Committee and Hungarian UNESCO Global Geoparks were present for a fruitful meeting in the exploration of further collaboration between the four countries' geopark committees.

4.4. Geodiversity day celebrations – 11.10.2024

A conference was organized to celebrate Geodiversity Day on the 11th of October in the Hungarian Natural History Museum with the assistance of the committee.

4.5 International Earth Day activities – 21–22.04.2024.

All three Hungarian UNESCO Global Geoparks organized dedicated geotours to the celebration of the International Earth Day; Bakony–Balaton UGGp in the Úrkút Palaeokarst Nature Conservation Area, Novohrad–Nógrád UGGp a Miocene tour in the Ipolytarnóc Fossils and Bükk Region UGGp to the Szeleta prehistoric man cave.
