3. GEOPARK ACTIVITIES

Major achievements in 2024

- January / December Project 'Gateways of the Park' - All the gateways of the Park were opened January / December "Park Gates" Project - All park entrances were opened, offering museum services, educational workshops, cultural events, exhibitions and guided excursions.

Management and Financial Status

The Park has an independent budget. The Park's financial sources come mainly from the Ministry of Environment. The annual budget is approved by the Management Committee. The Park Gates are managed by municipalities and financed by the Park

Geoconservation

- July 12 – September 3 Festival "Le Notti della Natura" – Series of scientific conferences of geological and naturalistic character with national-level science communicators and guided night visits to some geosites of the Geopark.
- Implementation of the Cornate and Fosini Regional Nature Reserve Visitor Center with educational projects for schools, outdoor activities, signage
- Study for the safety and opening to visitors of the 19th-century Santa Barbara gallery for the search of silver and copper minerals. The gallery is located in the town of Montieri, near the Church of San Giacomo and is included in the geopath system
- Creation of podcasts with interviews and the production of a documentary film about the history of Niccioleta and its mine
