3. GEOPARK ACTIVITIES

Major achievements in 2024

May -June: Art, culture, history, landscape and environment are the protagonists of the 19th edition of Egn Wek 2024, thanks to the precious collaboration of local associations and municipalities of the Madonie.

August: Kosmos event from the solar system to the heart of the earth by the Sottosale Association A journey through science, art, geology, astrophysics and chemistry, literature and music, held at the Italkali Salt Mine in Petralia Soprana, a site of the Unesco Madonie World Geopark.

September: Inauguration of the Pollina Adventure Park. A new attraction of the Madonie territory to implement the tourist offer of the Madonie UGG.

October: Participation in the national conference entitled "At the sources of our history - The identity stones", promoted by Archeclub and the Municipality of Cefalù at the Sala della Capriate, aimed at enhancing the territories, through geology, to strengthen the Madonie UGG.

November: Celebration of the 35th anniversary of the establishment of the Madonie Park Authority with the realization of guided tours and a conference entitled "New strategies for protected natural areas";

Participation in the "Flavors Without Borders" event which took place in Castelbuono, an event in the name of multiculturalism ;

Study and in-depth day, organized by the association "I Sud del Mondo" with the conference "Tourism, driving force for the economy and social development and on the great potential of the sector" in Mondello (Palermo);

Contribution towards GGN - Networking and participation

March: 49th European Geoparks Meeting Kula Salihli UNESCO Global Geopark – Turkey.

December: Celebration of the twentieth anniversary of the GGN in the Madonie Geopark with a Workshop of the Italian UGGps.

Management and Financial Status

The main financial entrance is from Sicily which shall transfer amounts allocated to the budget to pay all expenses related to institutional activities, to the geopark activity management and to the staff. The annual balance is approved by the Park Board, and it is subjected to the region control. Other sums came from private associations.

Geoconservation

Research project of the University of Palermo-Museum System Service Center concerning the study of the monumental population of the Agrifogli Giganti of Piano Pomo.

May: Work on the arrangement and safety of the Scopalacqua geosite.

November: Participation in Florence at the final workshop of the Life4Fir project on conservation strategies of the Madonie fir (Abies nebrodensis).

Sustainable tourism (Geotourism)

“International Geodiversity Day” - The Madonie Geopark celebrated this international event by organizing guided tours with students to promote the identity of the Madonie Geopark, through geology, environment, culture and natural heritage.

Project “Let's color our future” promoted by the “Castellana Sicula-Polizzi Generosa” Comprehensive Institute for the enhancement of the educational function of the Park School. As part of the Life4fir project, the Madonie Geopark has organised informative meetings and guided visits to the indigenous area of Abies nebrodensis with school groups, associations and institutions.

New education programmes on geoconservation, sustainable development and disaster risk reduction

Realization of the Climate Sentinels Project with schools with awareness-raising and training actions on issues relating to the knowledge and mitigation of climate change.

An Idea Competition has been set up for Italian schools on georisks: "Knowing georisks to best deal with them" in collaboration with the Maiella Geopark.

Participation in the Erasmus Project “REPAIR THE WORLD” aimed at teachers/educators to help them acquire knowledge, ecological skills and awareness on climate change, to transfer them to students (participating countries: Italy, Turkey, Poland and Spain).

As part of the Earth Planet Week 2024, several initiatives were organized:

The Maiella Geopark and the Madonie Geopark discussed the theme "Geodiversity and Georisks", together for the growth of new generations, in addition, a cultural and educational event was held regarding the study of the historical landslide of Petralia Sottana.

Participation in the working table “Training and territory” with the Pietro Domina State Institute of Petralia Sottana, the Madonie Geopark as a professionalizing resource in the training offer aimed at students.

Realization of the project "Discover nature" with the State Comprehensive Institute "Balsamo Pantolfini" of Termini Imerese;

Memorandum of Understanding between the Madonie Park Authority, the “Antonio Collisani” Civic Museum and the National Association of Natural Science Teachers of Palermo, for the implementation of educational and training courses for teachers, students and all citizens.
