Management and Financial Status

- Elaboration of the Marketing Action Plan 2024-2029, produced through the stakeholders' and visitors' sights;
- Advances towards the creation of an Agency of Sustainability Seridó Geopark through the LIDER Program developed by SEBRAE and public institutions;
- About BRL 271,270,94 or USD 46,246.54 was the total financial income registered in the financial movements of the public management instance;
- Regarding the external funds support within the internal, it was registered a total at about

BRL 389,822.10 or USD 70,394.23.

Geoconservation

- Discovery and studies of new Pleistocene Megafauna fossils occurrences in new potential geological sites, the discoveries were made by the rural local inhabitants from Parelhas municipality;
- Research regarding the relationship between geodiversity and geoheritage with extractive environments, especially in active mines and quarries, to keep an open dialogue to promote tourism and education, i.e., Mina Brejuí and Boqueirão geosites;
- Signalling installation containing geosites' interpretation and instruction of expected behavior in trails;

Sustainable tourism (Geotourism)

- Promotion of the 1st Geoproducts Exposition of the Seridó UNESCO Global Geopark;
- Divulcation in a stand of the Brazilian National Tourism Saloon 2024;
- Promotion of the RuralTur 2024 event on rural tourism;
- Receiving the first technical visit of the Vivejar Institute, a tourism operator focused on Community-Based Tourism, which led to the first expedition scheduled for 2025.

New education programmes on geoconservation, sustainable development and disaster risk reduction

- Training on Artisans, Territory, and Geodiversity in rural communities of the six municipalities of the geopark, focused on the stimulation of the creation of new handicrafts based on local geoheritage and cultural heritage;
- Multipliers of geodiversity knowledge on the Seridó Geopark program between partners and basic education;
- Mapping of geological risks in all 21 inventoried geosites, culminating in a technical report publication.

Strategic partnership

- Technical cooperation with the Oeste UGGp;
- Meeting with Youth Caatinga UNESCO Biosphere Reserve representatives;
- Partnership with the Brazilian Geological Survey to develop technical investigation on risks and promotion of geodiversity in the geopark;
- Agreement with the State Secretary and the State Company of Tourism in the Rio Grande do Norte to the international promotion of the geopark, marketing plan, and artisans'

capacitation;

- Meeting and advances for the cooperation agreement with the State Environment and Sustainable Development Institute (IDEMA).

Promotional activities

- Presentation of the territory at two international tourism fairs – the BTL Lisboa 2024 and the FITUR Madrid 2024, both with other Latin American Global Geoparks;
- Development of the Multipliers Program on Public Engagement, Geotourism and Visibility of the Seridó Geopark, generating web series of videos, website (visitegeoparqueserido.com.br), new social media platforms, and many other results;
- Participation in regional and national fairs to promote the geotourism, geoproducts, and local partners;
- Promotion of the RuralTUR 2024 and the 6th Seridó Geopark Meeting, exposing the highlights in terms of geotourism and associated production in the territory.
